## Challenge posed by COVID-19

- **Traditional methods of data collection interrupted**
- **Disruption of conventional work settings**





# IBGE mission during the pandemia

- **Maintain the regular production of national key data and surveys** (GDP, inflation rate, business statistics, unemployment rate, among others)
- **Generate data on the impacts of the pandemic** on the population and enterprises, to support public health policies and strategic decisions in the regional and national levels



# Maintaining the regular production

- March 17<sup>th</sup> 2020 – Suspension of all data collection field operations / Demographic Census postponed

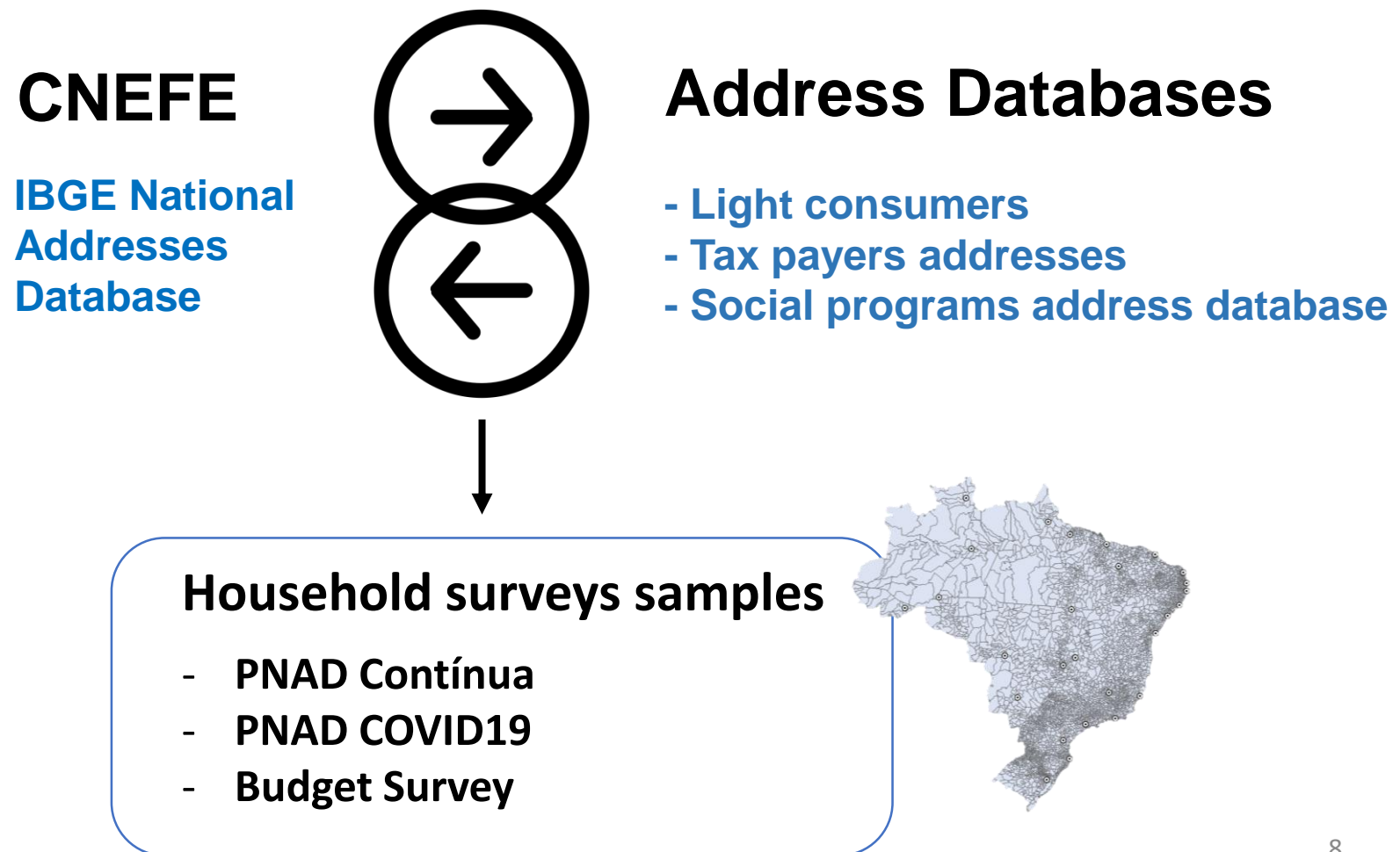

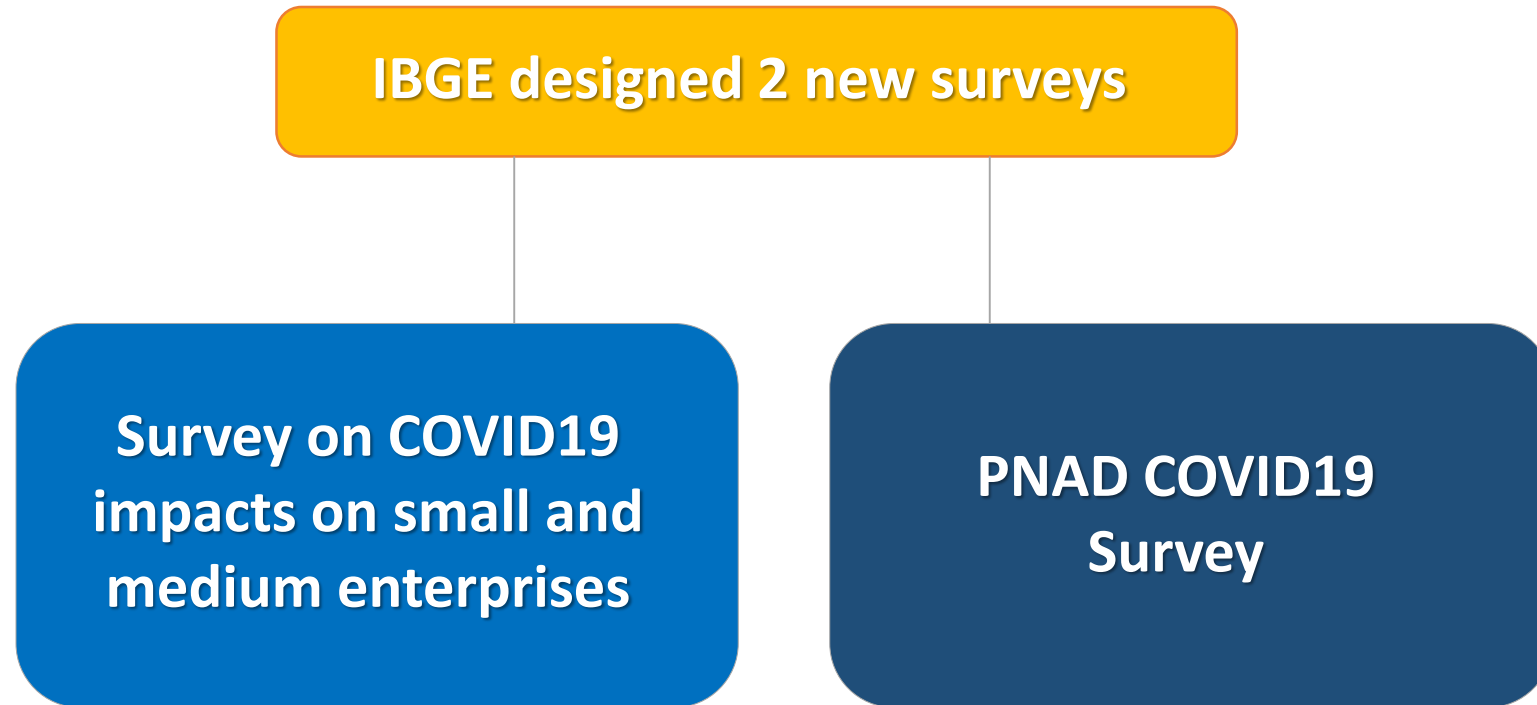

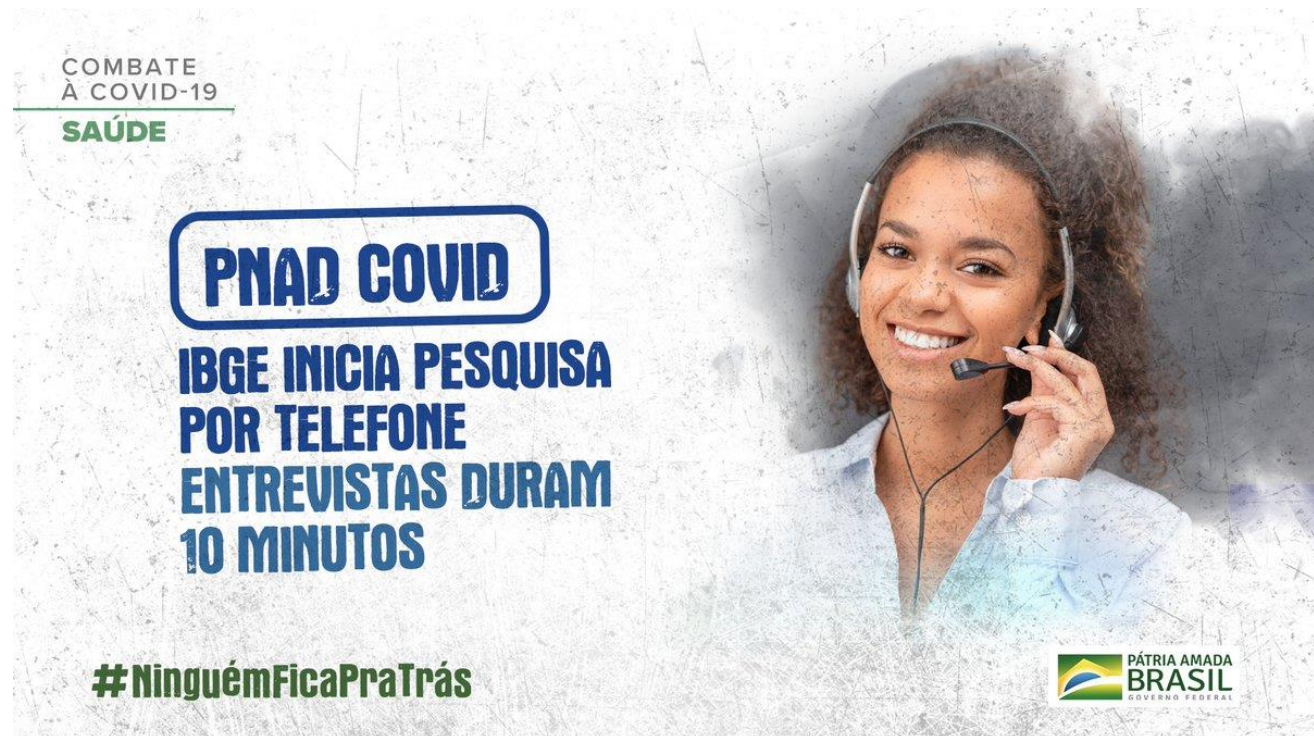

# Survey on COVID19 impacts on small and medium enterprises

## Purposes of the survey

- Obtain information about enterprises performance and measures taken against COVID impacts on their businesses.

## Some questionnaire themes

- Business environment
- Enterprise situation
- Payment and supply chain
- Demand for work
- Measures taken
- Government aid





# PNAD COVID19 Survey

## Purposes of the survey

- Obtain information about the symptoms associated with **COVID-19** and the measures taken against these symptoms.
- Obtain information from those who showed symptoms, sought a health care facility, and what kind of facility it was.
- Monitor the changes that happened in the Brazilian labour market during the COVID-19 pandemic.



## Distance learning scale up

- **ENCE university fully online**
- **Training courses revamped and adapted to new remote context**



# Data dissemination strategy

- **COVID-19 Hotsite**
- **Production of accessible dashboards to different stakeholders**



# **LESSONS LEARNED AND NEW CHALLENGES TO 2021 DEMOGRAPHIC CENSUS**

- **Mixed Mode Data Collection to Account for Uncertainty**
  - **Computer Assisted Personal Interview (CAPI)**
  - **Computer Assisted Telephone Interview (CATI)**
- **Computer Aided control of Census Operation in 3 Phases (Pre-Enumeration, Enumeration, and Post-Enumeration)**
  - **Grid Population Estimation helping the 3 phases**
  - **Artificial Intelligence tools for controlling the process in the field**
